The answers to the winter wheat risk assessment questions will determine whether the high or low risk premium rate is charged. Use crop codes: **Fall Rye - 7 (pedigreed - 407, organic - 707), Winter Wheat - 23 (pedigreed - 423, organic - 723)**. Please submit this Fall Seeded Acreage Report (SAR) after crop is seeded in the fall. The deadline to submit Fall SAR is November 15. Crop year is the year the crop is harvested and premium is charged, NOT the year the crop is seeded.

- Fall crops must be seeded by September 15 to be eligible for winterkill coverage.
- Although the crop is seeded in 2011, the crop is considered a 2012 crop because that is the year of harvest.
- High and low risk premium for winter wheat can be found on the 2011 Coverage Detail (What-If) form.

- 1 Numerical order of your current land as recorded at SCIC. If unknown, please leave blank.
- 2 Rural municipality and legal land description for each parcel of cultivated land.
- 3 Indicate crop code for fall rye or winter wheat acres.
- 4 Indicate the acres as summerfallow (SMF), stubble (STB), or irrigated (IRR).

- 5 Crop variety seeded.
- 6 Total acres seeded to that crop on the legal land description.
- 7 Date the crop was finished seeding per legal land description.
- 8 Winter wheat risk assessment questions:
 - List the crop seeded on the legal land description in the previous year or note summerfallow, if applicable.
 - Answer yes or no if stubble is standing.
 - Answer yes or no if there is enough stubble to trap at least six inches of snow.
- 9 Because this line contains crop code 7 (Fall Rye), you do not have to complete the **winter wheat risk assessment questions (#8)**.
