- All land owned and operated must be listed.
- Land additions or deletions should be made as soon as you are aware of the change.
- Crops on additional acres must have been endorsed by March 31, 2011 to be insurable.
- All land changes are subject to approval.
- Land changes may not be eligible for insurance if damage occurs before you notify SCIC.

- 1 Customer signature and date Seeded Acreage Report is completed.
- 2 Select this box if you would like to volunteer yields on uninsured forage crops. This information can be used to establish individual yield history for future forage insurance coverage.
- 3 The numerical order of your current land as recorded at SCIC. SCIC will assign a land code if you are adding land. Acres that SCIC has measured using Global Positioning Systems are designated as GPS.
- 4 Rural municipality where the land is located.

- 5 Legal land description for each parcel of cultivated land to be insured.
- 6 The total cultivated acres for the legal land description. All insured and uninsured crops, including tame hay, summerfallow, greenfeed, unseeded acres (too wet to seed) and diversification acres must add up to the total cultivated acres on each legal land description.
- 7 List the number of cultivated acres that could not be seeded because it was too wet to seed. If acres are too wet to work or seed, **report as too wet and not summerfallow.**
- 8 TO DELETE, draw a line through the entire land description.

- 9 Acres measured by GPS cannot be changed without customer service office manager approval.
- 10 TO CORRECT, draw a line through the item you wish to change and write the new information below.
- 11 TO ADD, print the legal land description for each quarter and the total cultivated acres in the blank spaces provided.
- 12 List one insured or uninsured seeded crop per column. You must report all acres that are underseeded to another crop.
- 13 Crop codes can be found on the Crop Reference List or in *Your Complete Guide to Understanding Crop Insurance.*
- 14 List seeded acres as summerfallow (SMF), stubble (STB) or irrigated (IRR).
- 15 List the crop variety.
- 16 Total seeded acres per crop per page.
- 17 Last seeding date per crop.
- 18 The grand total of acres (listed on the last Seeded Acreage Report page).

Your Seeded Acreage Report Checklist

- Have you included all acres and land that you own and operate in this report (insured and uninsured)?
- Do your reported acres match your total cultivated acres?
- Have you accurately reported acres intended for summerfallow in 2011?
- Have you accurately reported 2011 seeded acres that are eligible for summerfallow coverage in 2011?
- Have you reported all underseeded acres?
- Have you reported your crop varieties and seeding dates?
